#### WHAT IS THE PTO?

We have movie nights, ice cream events and community gatherings throughout the year like our Fall Festival in October and Family Fiesta in the Spring.

Teacher Support- Every year, we raise enough funds to supply each teacher with classroom supplies. The PTO also supports the teachers by listening to their concerns and requests, collectively coming up with ways to help and then trying our hardest to accomplish those goals.
